

# Manual for the WADD Annual Congress as a joint meeting with a National Scientific Society

25th June 2025 version

# **Purpose of This Manual**

This manual outlines the guidelines, requirements, and mutual commitments for members of WADD National Countries to host a **National Congress in strategic alliance with WADD.** 

This document also serves as the **formal agreement** for the joint organization between the WADD and the host National Scientific Society (NSS)

# **General Collaboration Agreement**

- The National Congress will be held entirely by the host (NSS), under WADD's institutional umbrella.
- The WADD provides strategic, academic, and international value, enhancing the Congress's global visibility and impact.
- The NSS will act as the local host and will cover all the Congress expenses, assuming financial responsibility.
- The WADD will collaborate in the Scientific Program, facilitating topics and speakers as well as assessment.

# **Requirements and Commitments**

#### 1. Official Language and Accessibility

- The official language of the Congress should include both English and the official language of the host country, or only **English**.
- Congress must provide simultaneous translation into English for all key sessions.
- All event materials (program, schedule, website content, parallel activities, certificates) must be available in **English** or in a **bilingual format** (local language + English).



 English versions of all communications are essential for international accessibility.

#### 2. Visibility and Promotion by WADD

The WADD will promote the Congress extensively through:

- WADD official website, including information of details.
- The **WADD** newsletter, WADD Dual Disorders Digest, will be distributed to its global membership.
- Social media channels and partner institutions.

Moreover, WADD members and institutional partners are actively encouraged to support the **international promotion of the Congress**, ensuring **broad outreach** within the scientific community.

#### 3. International Speakers

 The WADD will provide renowned international speakers, selected from its members and scientific networks, to enhance the academic level and international appeal of the Congress.

#### 4. Speakers waivers

• The WADD speakers shall receive **free registration** at the Congress. At least a **minimum of five free registrations** must be granted to speakers invited by WADD.

# **Logistical Requirements**

WADD General Assembly

- The Congress must provide a dedicated, fully equipped **meeting room** to host the **WADD General Assembly**, which will be:
  - o **Held in person** for attendees on site.
  - Will include online connection to allow remote participation by WADD members.
  - The room and technical equipment will be at the expense of the Congress organization
- The WADD Secretariat staff must also receive:
  - o Free Congress registration.



o **Travel, accommodation, and on-site expenses fully covered** by the Congress, as will be present to support WADD's operations during the preparation of the congress and the on-site event.

# **Benefits for the National Scientific Society**

- Immediate international visibility for the Congress and host organization.
- Access to global networks of researchers and institutional partners.
- Participation of high-level international speakers.
- Academic and Scientific support from WADD.
- Promotion of the event through WADD's global channels.
- Opportunities for future collaborations and joint projects in the host Country.

## **Benefits for WADD Members**

Discount on the Congress Fees for WADD members, strengthening the national scientific institution through internationalization.

### **Financial Terms**

#### Contribution Based on International Registrations

- The Host National Committee agrees to transfer 10% of the total income from international participant registrations to WADD.
- This contribution supports the continued global efforts and operational sustainability of the WADD and its collaboration with national events.

# **Agreement Formalization**

By accepting this manual, both parties — the WADD and the hosting National Scientific Society — agree to the terms, responsibilities, and standards outlined herein.

This document serves as the **formal basis** for the joint organization of the Congress and the advancement of international scientific cooperation.
